The **Keystone Moviegraph** is patented under the following patent numbers: 55107 and 1345793. Other patents pending.

The **Keystone Moviegraph** is absolutely guaranteed to show clear and large pictures. It is more simple to operate and has less parts for a user to assemble than any other machine on the market.

The **Keystone Moviegraph** is equipped with **Non-Inflammable Film**.

The **Keystone Moviegraph** is manufactured for either standard gauge film or narrow gauge film.

The Standard or Theatre gauge is $1\frac{3}{8}$ in. wide.

The Narrow gauge is $1\frac{1}{8}$ in. wide. The reason we manufacture a machine to take narrow gauge film is that there is a demand for a machine with a sprocket barrel that will not fit the regular theatre film. We manufacture this machine in the following numbers: 147N, 154N, 261N, 193N, 198N, 572N, 575N, to conform with the specification of the Underwriters' Laboratories, Inc. (**The Keystone Moviegraph in these numbers are the only toy motion picture machines that are included in the list of inspected electrical appliances issued by UNDERWRITERS LABORATORIES**).

The film on all machines excepting the \$5.00 and \$7.00 models can be framed without opening the front door.

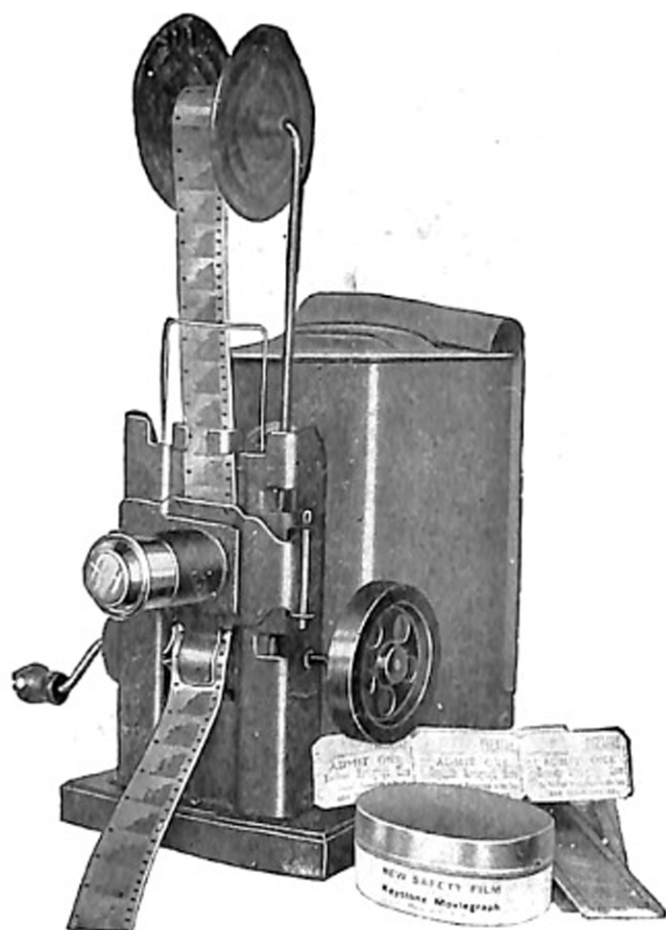
