It is no exaggeration to say that anything of suitable size you can possibly think of may be placed upon the disc of the *Designoscope* and it will be found that the description of this wonderful little instrument as the "Wonder of Modern Art" is fully justified.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE.

The Designoscope is mounted by inserting the two prongs in the sockets provided. The objects selected are placed upon the white disc or plate. Apply the eye to the small opening in the top of the instrument and slowly revolve the disc.
