


FOLLOW THESE EASY STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS



REAL SOUND MOVIE PROJECTOR


Step 1 continued

- Lay the open projector on its side.
- ☐ Lift out the **DIAGRAM SHEET.** KEEP THE DIAGRAM SHEET to help you put the sound film into the projector. Diagram also helps you identify the parts.




Step 2 • PUT IN THE BATTERIES

Use five (5) size "D" batteries.



Place 2 batteries in the bottom of the battery compartment, positive ends (with knobs) pointing LEFT.



- Place 3 batteries in the top of the battery compartment, positive ends pointing to RIGHT.
- ☐ Turn on Switch to see that both lamps go on. If they do not, check batteries for correct position.

NOTE: If SOUND LAMP does not appear to be lighted, that may be because it is turned down. Turn SOUND CONTROL wheel up until light can be seen, then down again.

WHEN USING PROJECTOR, ALWAYS TURN SOUND LAMP DOWN UNTIL AFTER THE SWITCH IS TURNED ON, THEN ADJUST SOUND.

Step 3 • CHECK BOTH LAMPS

PICTURE LAMP POSITION


Turn on switch.

- □ The picture lamp should throw a round beam of light that completely surrounds and fills the PICTURE LIGHT OPENING. If it does not, remove the PICTURE LAMP COVER by squeezing the sides and lifting.
- □ Turn the bulb in its holder and also swing the holder up or down to aim the beam at the opening.

SOUND LAMP POSITION

- Turn the Sound Control Wheel to make the sound lamp bulb glow very dim.
- Squeeze the sides of the SOUND LAMP COVER and lift it off.
- Turn the bulb in its holder so the loop of filament appears edgewise as shown——
- Swing the holder left or right to line up the glowing tip of the filament with the 2 raised Aiming Marks on the Sound Guide

REPLACE BOTH LAMP COVERS WHEN FINISHED.




POSITION OF FILAMENT IN BULB








Step 4 • PREPARE THE FILM CARTRIDGE





- INSERT THE FILM CARTRIDGE. Lower the cartridge into the chamber at left of projector. Snap end "B" of the bracket into slot "B" in chamber, and end "A" into slot "A".
- POSITION THE FILM, following the path marked by the arrows in the projector. Shown full size on the Diagram Sheet.
- BE SURE TO ALLOW SLACK in the film between the MAIN SPROCKET and the CORNER GUIDE PIN.
- ☐ Close the projector.

OPERATING YOUR PROJECTOR



With sound lamp turned down, turn on switch.

CRANKING • Turn crank forward (clockwise). Several turns are needed before the film starts to move.



NEVER TURN THE CRANK BACKWARDS— that may permanently damage the mechanism.


Your Real Sound Projector will produce normal sound and action when cranked at even speed, but it's fun to change effects by cranking faster or slower.

FOCUSING • Slide the LENS TUBE in or out to focus the picture on a wall or screen.

SOUND CONTROL • Now turn Sound Control Wheel up until you get the best VOLUME and CLARITY.

CHANGING FILM CARTRIDGES

- ☐ Turn off switch, open projector and lay it on its side. Gently lift film out from all the guides.
- Lift out the cartridge by squeezing the bracket to release ends "A" and "B" from the slots.



- REWIND THE LOOP OF FILM. Hold the cartridge by the bracket and spin the disc clockwise until all the slack has been taken up.
- Insert another film cartridge into the projector as you did in Steps 4 and 5.

IMPORTANT: REMOVE FILM AND REWIND ON THE CARTRIDGE WHEN YOU HAVE FINISHED PLAYING WITH THE PROJECTOR.

• HELPFUL HINTS

If you have not followed all instructions some of the following adjustments may be necessary.

IF THIS OCCURS	DO THIS
No light	1. Turn on switch.2. Make sure batteries are properly installed.3. Replace and adjust picture lamp bulb.
Dim light	Replace batteries.
Picture blurred	Adjust the focus.
Picture jumps or slides by	Check that film has sufficient slack between the main sprocket and the corner guide pin as shown in diagram.
No sound	 Turn sound control wheel counter-clockwise. See that film is properly positioned. Make sure all batteries are properly installed. Replace sound bulb if burned out.
Sound too low or not clear	1. Check position of sound lamp (Step 3). 2. Replace batteries.
If film breaks, any camera dealer or any person familia	ar with home movies can join the film with 16mm splicing tape.

If film breaks, any camera dealer or any person familiar with home movies can join the film with 16mm splicing tape.

If servicing is necessary, take your projector to your radio repairman. Circuit drawing is inside.

TO REPLACE THE PICTURE LAMP • Extra No. 246 bulb is included. Lift off the lamp cover and pry the bulb out of the holder. Press in the new bulb and adjust as in Step 3.

TO REPLACE THE SOUND LAMP • Extra No. 245 bulb is included. Press back on the metal spring at the base of the bulb and lift bulb out. Replace with new bulb and adjust as in Step 3.
