

ILLUMINATION



Is by Ever-Ready U.2 $1\frac{1}{2}$ volts (leak proof) batteries (two are used), Ever-Ready Lens End Bulb, 2.2 volts, No. 2225, or connect to special transformer.

We strongly advise that this projector is used in a completely darkened room.

Projecting 4 ft. from the screen, your picture size will be $9'' \times 6\frac{3}{4}''$ (approx.)

For Colour Film it is advised that you project nearer the screen than for Black and White.



Every angle of entertainment is provided for, be it Comedy, Westerns, Sport or Pageantry. All films have been edited and cut to definite suitable lengths and joined for easy continuous showing. Each film loop is packed in its own individual box and clearly titled, thus enabling easy storage and instant selection of titles.



FOR BEST RESULTS ~

(!) Make sure your Ever-Ready U.2 Batteries are inserted in the correct fashion as per the instructions, or, if run from mains, connect Transformer leads to sockets provided. These are clearly marked on the projector.

(2) Switch on by slightly pulling out the baseplate.

(3) Put arm-piece holding focusing lens and guide spool into grooves provided.

Before inserting film in gate and over guide spool, adjust bulb adjuster arm at side of lamphouse, to centre light on to condenser lens on the gate housing. Look at the screen whilst adjusting till you obtain an even white light. Then insert the film in the gate carefully, allow the film door to close, pull film slightly down to engage into claw, then you are ready to hand turn and project.

(5) Re-focus by moving front lens back and forth until the picture is sharp. This is easily done by gripping the rigid part of the focusing lens.

(6) All films must be put in gate with picture UPSIDE DOWN, with holes to the right.

Project nearer screen when showing colour films.
USE EVER-READY U.2 BATTERIES (LEAK PROOF), ALSO THE EVER-READY 2.2 LENS END ALL BATTERIES AND BULBS ARE OBTAINABLE FROM YOUR LOCAL ELECTRICAL DEALERS AND IN MANY CASES YOUR TOY SHOP.

(8) Keep condenser lens clean - by occasionally wiping with clean cloth
