Now you can enjoy the beautiful color scenes of your GAF® View-Master® reels on the TV-like screen of your Rear Screen Projector. It is also great for entertaining friends.

USING PROJECTOR

Unwind cord. Place projector on convenient flat surface. Make sure that air intake openings on the bottom and the grille on the top of the projector are unobstructed: air must be allowed to circulate freely in lamp housing to prevent overheating.

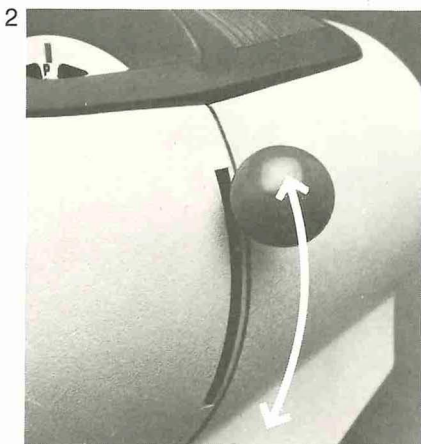
Insert reel into slot behind carrying handle, with printed "P" or "UP FOR PROJECTOR" on top, facing front of projector (**Fig. 1**). Push in reel as far as it will go; do not force it.

Move down scene change lever all the way to position first scene

(**Fig. 2**). Raise lever slowly into original position; do not let it snap back.

Lamp will turn on as you plug cord into standard 120 volt 50 or 60 Hz AC household outlet. Watch the image on projector screen while you focus by moving handle back and forth slowly (**Fig. 3**). Stop handle when image is sharpest.

To show next picture, move down scene change lever as far as it will go, then let it return slowly. After all the scenes are shown, remove reel by pulling it straight up.

Note: Do not touch grille on top of lamp housing: after prolonged use of projector the grille may get quite warm.

After use, remove power cord from outlet and let projector cool. Wind cord around bracket on bottom plate before putting away projector.

Important:

Your GAF VIEW-MASTER Rear Screen Projector is equipped with a lamp which will last the life of the projector. However, should lamp problems occur, lamp will be replaced free of charge during warranty period.*

Consult your dealer before returning projector for repair. He can help you determine the problem. If service is required, pack projector carefully and send it prepaid to the nearest GAF Consumer Photo Service Center. Include your name and address, description of difficulty, date of purchase, as well as name and address of selling dealer.

*After warranty period lamp will be changed at a nominal charge.
